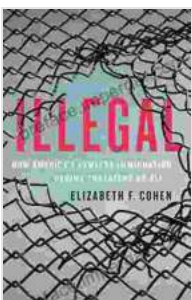

Total Tax Contributions by Illegal Aliens

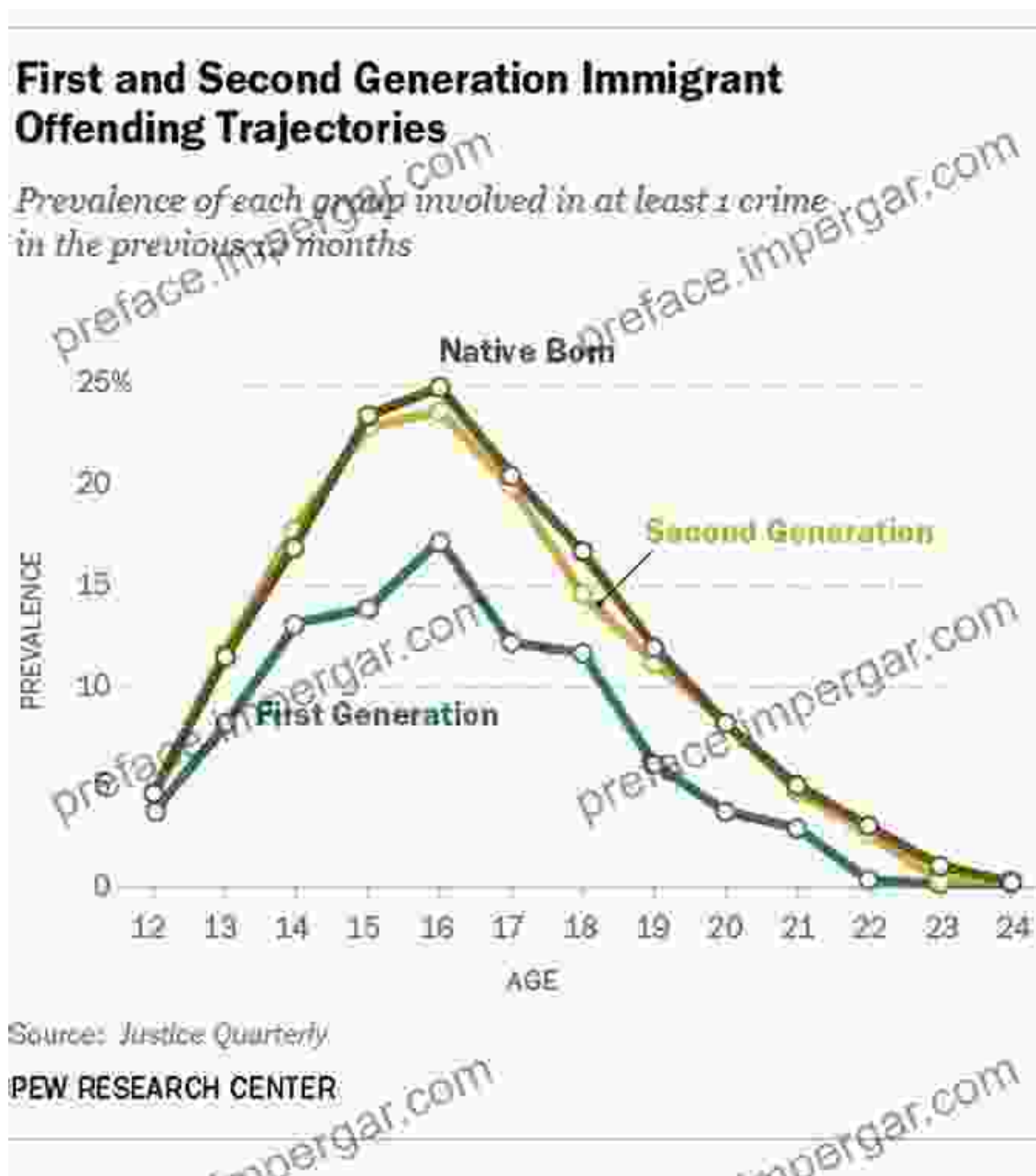
